Changes to the Recreational Rules for Hapuku/Bass

The regulations come into force on 28 November 2022.

- Daily limit for Hapuku/Bass reduced from 5 to 2 per person per day.
- An accumulation limit of 3 Hapuku/Bass per person.
- The combined daily bag limit of 5 Hapuku/Bass and Kingfish will be removed. (Kingfish daily bag limit remains the same at 3 per person per day)
